2.1.2 Percentage of seats filled against reserved categories (SC, ST, OBC etc.) as per applicable reservation policy for the first year admission during the last five years

- The institute offers B. Pharm, Pharm D and M. Pharm programmes in five specialization subjects, Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance (PQA), Pharmacology, Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Pharmacognosy.
- The Programmes are approved by AICTE, Pharmacy Council of India and Savitribai Phule Pune University.
- Admissions for these programmes are made as per the directives of Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Admission regulating Authority and Common Entrance test Cell, Maharashtra State.
- As per norms, 80% of the total seats are filled by the competent authority through centralized admission process (CAP) and 20% seats (management seats) are filled at the institute level (IL) by the institute.
- The seats remaining vacant at the end of CAP Round 1 and Round 2 or due to non-reporting, non-admission / cancellation of candidates or due to any other reason are filled at institute level (ACAP seats) by counseling round.
