Meeting Minutes

BoS Meeting No.: 01

The first meeting of the Board of Studies (BoS) in PharmD for the academic year 2025-26 was held on 6th August 2025 at 1:00 PM in hybrid mode (Offline/Online) at IQAC Room, Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's College of Pharmacy Panchavati, Nashik 422003, under the chairmanship of Dr. Rupali A. Patil

Minutes of the Meeting

The meeting commenced with a warm welcome by the Chairperson, Dr. Rupali A. Patil (HOD Pharm D), who expressed gratitude to all members for their valuable presence. She highlighted the importance of curriculum revision and collaboration between Courses, workshop, Hospital, Industry, and educational institutions.

Agenda No. 01. Approval of Modified syllabus for Pharm. D. (2025-26)

Discussion:

The modified syllabus for the PharmD program for the academic year 2025–26 was presented for review. The revisions included subject-wise restructuring, updated course outcomes aligned with Bloom's taxonomy, and adjustments in teaching hours based on PCI guidelines and current healthcare trends. Inputs were invited from faculty members to ensure that the revised syllabus meets academic standards, industry expectations within specified hours by PCI Syllabus. After thorough discussion, the proposed modifications were reviewed for final approval.

Modifications discussed included:

- Human Anatomy and Physiology (Theory and Practical)
- Pharmaceutics (Theory and Practical)
- Medicinal Biochemistry (Theory and Practical)
- Pharmaceutical Organic Chemistry (Theory and Practical)
- Pharmaceutical Inorganic Chemistry (Theory and Practical)

Resolution:

The Board unanimously resolved to approve the modified syllabus for the Pharm. D. program for the academic year 2025-26 as presented. The revised curriculum, which includes subject-wise restructuring and updates to theory and practical components, was reviewed in detail.

- An introductory module on the use of microscopes has been added to the **Human Anatomy and Physiology** practical curriculum, as agreed upon by the BoS members.
- A basic overview of artificial bone transplantation and 3D bioprinting has been incorporated, following the suggestions of Dr. Anupama Konneru and Prof. Punam Aher.

- Content on various glandular disorders has been added, based on the recommendation of Dr. Suvarna P. Ingle. An expanded section on gut microbiota now includes information on prebiotics, as suggested by Dr. Bhavin Vyas and Dr. Milind Deore.
- Additional practicals in Pharmaceutics have been approved by the Board of Studies (BoS) members.
- In Pharmaceutical Inorganic Chemistry, specify which cleaning agents (cleansers) and Pesticides were adopted based on the recommendation given by Dr. Anupama Konneru. and Prof. Punam Aher.
- Lab safety added as separate component in the Practical Course.

An industrial visit provides students first-hand exposure to real-world work environments, helping bridge the gap between theory and practice. Discussing about formal MoU with a hospital was signed to enhance clinical training, internships, and collaborative projects. Also, Additionally, curriculum-based workshops were organized to provide hands-on learning directly tailored to the subjects being taught.
